SCHOLARSHIP

The funds for the Ernst and Young Alumni Scholarship have been provided by ORU accounting graduates and supporters who work for the national CPA firm of Ernst and Young. We are certainly pleased by the generosity and vision of our alumni at Ernst and Young in continuing to contribute to this annual scholarship.

The selection of scholarship recipients will be made this semester and the funds for the scholarship will be awarded for the 2005-2006 academic year at ORU. The scholarship may be applied totally to the fall semester or may be split equally between the fall and spring semesters.

The criteria established by the donors are that the scholarship recipient must:

1. Be an accounting major
2. Have completed a minimum of 60 college hours prior to this semester
3. Have a minimum cumulative GPA of 3.0
4. Have completed a minimum of 9 hours in accounting
